## Program Overview

The Louisiana Co-Payment and Deductible Assistance Program (CDAP) is a federally funded program through the Office of Public Health's HIV/AIDS Program. The purpose of CDAP is to assist qualified individuals with co-payments and deductibles as specified by the applicant's insurance plan, including both private insurance carriers as well as Medicare Parts B and D, for:

- a) medications
- b) physician visits
- c) laboratory work
- d) diagnostic tests

\* Recertification is required on an annual basis to maintain participation in the CDAP Program\*

### Eligibility

- **HIV+/AIDS Diagnosis**
- **Louisiana Residency**
- **Proof of Income (Income not to exceed 300% of the federal poverty guidelines)**
- **Proof of Insurance**
- **Schedule/Summary of Benefits from insurance provider**
- **Proof of current Low Income Subsidy application (for persons receiving Medicare benefits)**
- **Consent to Release**

### Program Exclusions

- **Dental Services**
- **In-patient hospital stays**
- **Erectile Dysfunction Drugs**
- **Discount Health and Pharmacy Plans**
- **Products or services not covered by the primary insurance carrier**
