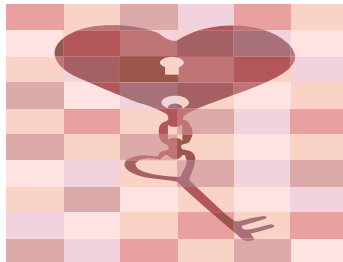
Eligibility Criteria

Supportive and Transitional Housing Programs:

Participants must be homeless, disabled, and or having substance abuse and or mental health problems. Income is not required; however, client must pay deposits and utilities.

Tenant Based Housing Program:

Participants must be disabled, have verifiable income, and pay a portion of rent and utilities.



HAART's housing programs provide opportunities for permanent and transitional housing for homeless persons with disabilities. Target populations include those who are chronically homeless and diagnosed with a physical disability, mental illness, alcohol or substance abuse. Programs can be re-funded annually. Housing is available in Baton Rouge and surrounding parishes.

Participants in the program will be expected to:

- Comply with rules of the program and landlords.
- Have regular contact with their case manager.
- Desire change and participate in active life plan.
- Participate in mental health and/or substance abuse treatment.
- Seek and follow medical care.
